Summary of Tariff Changes

The changes to the Tariff can be assigned to four categories as follows:

- 1. Required changes to clarify Tariff consistent with Company practices.
- 2. Movement or deletion of sections.
- 3. Clean-up changes such as rewording, referencing, punctuation, formatting and grammatical corrections that do not affect the meaning or applicability of the Tariff.
- 4. Substantive change explained in testimony.

The following summary provides a brief description of the tariff changes along with the sections affected and the category of each proposed change. Some section numbers have changed. They are detailed in the table below. The reference to 'section affected' corresponds to the proposed language section numbers.
