NOTICE TO THE COMMISSION OF
PACIFIC ENERGY & MINING
COMPANY'S CHAPTER 11
BANKRUPTCY FILING**

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) provides the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) this notice of Pacific Energy & Mining Company's (PEMC's) bankruptcy filing so that the Commission may have notice of the upcoming 341 creditors meeting, believed to be scheduled for August 13, 2019, and take appropriate action in the bankruptcy proceeding concerning the treatment of the \$100,000 penalty the Commission levied against PEMC.¹

¹ On April 10, 2019, the Commission issued its Hazardous Facility Order (Order) finding that PEMC "remains in violation of 49 C.F.R § 192 concerning Items 1-11 listed above" and ordered that "within sixty (60) days of this order, PEMC shall cease operation of its pipeline and it may not recommence operation until it successfully petitions the PSC to discontinue the order to cease operations," and that "PEMC shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$100,0000, payable to the state of Utah, within 120 days of the date of this order." See Order at pp. 25 and 30. After further proceedings before the Commission, PEMC appealed the Order. PEMC's appeal is pending before the Utah Court of Appeals. See Pacific Energy and Mining Company v. Public Service Commission, Case No. 20190444-CA.

On July 10, 2019, PEMC filed a voluntary petition for Chapter 11 bankruptcy in the United States Bankruptcy Court, District of Utah. The petition, Case 19-25030, was filed by PEMC's president, Tariq Ahmad, and listed Terry R. Spencer, Ph.D., as PEMC's attorney for the bankruptcy matter. A copy of PEMC's bankruptcy petition and its initial accompanying list of creditors is attached as Exhibit 1. The Commission was not listed on the initial filed list of creditors although the Division was listed. On July 16, 2019, the Division provided notice to Mr. Spencer that the penalty was assessed by the Commission, not the Division.
