Recommendation (No Action Required)

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has reviewed the Application, as filed. The filing appears to constitute a complete filing as required by Commission rule R746-700-10, -20, -21, and -22.

Issue

On July 1, 2019, Dominion Energy Utah (DEU) filed a General Rate Case Application with the Utah Public Service Commission (PSC). The Commission issued an action request asking the Division to determine if DEU's Application constitutes a complete filing. Per Utah Code §54-7-12(2)(b)(ii), parties have 14 days to challenge the completeness of filing per the Commission's rules.
