Dear Mr. Mendenhall,

The Public Service Commission (PSC) has reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) Energy Efficiency (EE) report for year ending December 31, 2018, filed on March 27, 2019. The PSC has also reviewed the Division of Public Utility's (DPU) April 25, 2019 comments ("DPU Annual Report"). The DPU Annual Report, filed pursuant to the PSC's January 16, 2007 Order in Docket No. 05-057-T01, recommended the PSC acknowledge DEU's December 31, 2018 EE Report.

The DPU's comments summarize DEU's 2018 EE programs, compares the EE programs' budgets and forecasts with year-end actual results, and presents Utility Cost Test results for the several EE programs. The DPU also references the Air Sealing measure budgetary issues under the ThermWise Weatherization Program and requests that DEU discuss these results the next DSM Advisory Committee meeting. The PSC supports the DPU's recommendation and, therefore, requests DEU ensure the Air Sealing measure results be discussed at the next DSM Advisory Committee meeting, as proposed in the DPU Annual Report.

The PSC currently receives courtesy copies of all quarterly EE reports DEU files with the DPU; the PSC concludes acknowledgment of DEU's December 31, 2018 EE Report compliance filing is unnecessary. The PSC appreciates the DPU's review of DEU's EE reports and supports DEU's ongoing collaborative efforts with the DPU in ensuring the various EE reports and the DSM Advisory Committee remain valuable means for monitoring and examining energy efficiency and cost-effectiveness issues.
