Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) August 5, 2019 filing of a Notice of Expenditures-to-Date Report ("Report") pertaining to expenditures associated with the 2019 Market Transformation Program ("Program"). The filing was made pursuant to the PSC's January 12, 2010 Order in Docket No. 09-057-15.<sup>1</sup> The Report provides notice that as of June 2019, Program spending exceeded 50% (i.e., \$0.67 million or 51%) of its 2019 approved budget of \$1.3 million.

The PSC also reviewed the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) September 4, 2019 comments addressing the Report. According to the DPU, DEU forecasts the Program spending will not exceed the \$1.3 million 2019 budget. The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge DEU's Report as meeting the reporting requirements approved by the PSC in Docket No. 09-057-15.

Based on the PSC's review of DEU's Report and the DPU's comments, the PSC acknowledges DEU's Notice of Expenditures-to-Date Report as meeting the relevant reporting requirements.
