## Re: Dominion Energy Utah's Application for Approval of the 2020 Year Budget for Energy Efficiency Programs and Market Transformation Initiatives, Docket No. 19-057-26; and Dominion Energy Utah's Energy Efficiency Reports, 2020, Docket No. 20-057-01

Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) August 6, 2020 filing of a Notice of Expenditures-to-Date Report ("Report"). The filing was made pursuant to the PSC's January 12, 2010 Order in Docket No. 09-057-15.<sup>1</sup> The Report provides notice that in April 2020 the Energy Comparison Report Program spending exceeded 50% (i.e., \$0.29 million or 51%) of its 2020 approved budget of \$0.57 million. In addition, in May 2020: 1) the Builder Program spending exceeded 50% (i.e., \$3.15 million or 54%) of its 2020 approved budget of \$5.8 million; 2) the Business Program spending exceeded 50% (i.e., \$1.7 million or 55%) of its 2020 approved budget of \$3.1 million; and 3) the Market Transformation Program spending exceeded 50% (i.e., \$0.67 million or 51%) of its 2020 approved budget of \$1.3 million.

The PSC also reviewed the September 2, 2020 filing by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) recommending the PSC acknowledge the Report as meeting the reporting requirements approved in Docket No. 09-057-15. According to DPU, DEU forecasts it will spend 97% of the 2020 Energy Efficiency budget.

Based on the PSC's review of DEU's Report and DPU's comments, the PSC acknowledges DEU's Report as meeting the relevant reporting requirements.
