The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) adjusted Replacement Infrastructure (RI) 2020 Annual Plan and Budget ("Adjusted 2020 Plan") filed on March 31, 2020, and the Division of Public Utilities' (DPU) comments filed on April 28, 2020. Consistent with the PSC's February 25, 2020 Report and Order in Docket No. 19-057-02 ("February 2020 Order"), DEU's Adjusted 2020 Plan reduces the annual RI budget to \$72.2 million from the \$80 million identified in DEU's original RI 2020 Plan and Budget ("Original 2020 Plan") filed on November 15, 2019.

The DPU recommends the PSC acknowledge the Adjusted 2020 Plan. According to DPU, the Adjusted 2020 Plan is consistent with DEU's Utah PSC Tariff No. 500 § 2.07 and reduces the planned budget pertaining to Feeder Line 47. The DPU states that aside from this change the Adjusted 2020 Plan is otherwise unaltered from the Original 2020 Plan.

Based on the PSC's review of the Adjusted 2020 Plan and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges that the Adjusted 2020 Plan complies with the reporting requirement approved by the PSC in Docket No. 13-057-05 and is consistent with the February 2020 Order.
