Community Survey

Gathering input from residents during the General Plan updating process is essential to the success of the final plan. The Eureka City General Plan survey was created and distributed throughout the community to bring together citizen feedback. Youth from Eureka distributed the survey to all available households ****FIND THE DATES****. Approximately 99 surveys were completed by citizens and shows the level of commitment of Eureka residents towards their city. These surveys also provide validity to the General Plan process of representing the voice of the community.

Survey results largely confirmed the ideas stated in the General Plan. Some important ideas represented in the survey and General Plan include historical preservation, public facilities, and economic development.

The following charts and tables are presented as results from the 2017 Eureka City General Plan Survey. A copy of the survey is also included.




Figure 13.1: Response to the question, “Which category best describes your age?”




Figure 13.2: Response to the question, “How long have you lived in Eureka?”




Figure 13.3: Response to the question, "Please select the statement that best represents your situation."




Figure 13.4: Response to the question, "If employed, select the option that best describes the industry in which you would work."




Figure 13.5: Response to the question, "Which types of new housing do you feel should be allowed in Eureka?"




Figure 13.6: Response to the question, "If the following housing choices were to be allowed in Eureka, which (if any) should be restricted to certain zones within the City?"




Figure 13.7: Response to the question, "Do you favor or oppose encouraging commercial growth in the City?"




Figure 13.8: Response to the question, "Where in the City should commercial growth occur?"




Figure 13.10: Response to the question, “What improvements would you like to see in the roadway infrastructure?”




Figure 13.11: Response to the question, “How do you feel about the statement: ‘The City should encourage or sponsor more cultural events?’”




Figure 13.12: Response to the question, “Would you be in favor of annexing adjacent areas to accommodate growth?”




Figure 13.13: Response to the question, “If in favor (regarding annexation), would you be in favor of?”
