

We are excited to be bringing clean efficient natural gas to the community of Eureka.

These are the Steps needed for installing natural gas to your home after the service line installation is complete.

## Step One:

Hire a licensed or qualified heating contractor to come identify what is needed in your home to switch to natural gas. Some equipment can be converted by switching orifices, while other equipment that is compatible with natural gas may need to be installed. A contractor can give you a bid and identify what steps or equipment may be needed in your home specifically. These changes could include: new gas lines, installing or replacing equipment, or bringing in proper combustion air and venting for your natural gas appliances.


## **Step Two:**

After identifying the needed steps for your home, you must then obtain a city permit and work with the inspector/city to have your gas lines and equipment inspected. You must have the fuel lines air-tested and obtain a city clearance that will be sent to Dominion Energy by the inspector/city. The pressure test should be completed by a licensed contractor or qualified individual. The city inspector will inspect the line to ensure it is holding pressure and is safe. He will also inspect to make sure your equipment and utility room are up to code. Once these steps are completed, he will then send the city clearance to Dominion Energy.

## **Step Three:**

In order to make the transition as smooth as possible, please **contact Dominion Energy (1-800-323-5517)** as soon as the line installation/air test is nearing completion and the city inspector has sent the approved city clearances. We will then schedule an install to connect your fuel line to our natural gas system, as well as install a gas meter (entry point) to your home as soon as possible. You will be provided with a confirmation number if the line clearance has been submitted to Dominion Energy correctly.
