## APPLICATION

Questar Gas Company dba Dominion Energy Utah (Dominion Energy or Company) respectfully applies to the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) for approval of the Agreement for Municipal Transportation Service to Blanding, Utah entered into between the city of Blanding and the Company on May 21, 2020 ("Blanding Agreement"). The Blanding Agreement is attached hereto as DEU Exhibit 1.02. The Company supports this request as follows:

- 1. Dominion Energy is a public utility engaged in the distribution of natural gas to customers in Utah, Idaho and Wyoming. Its Utah and Idaho public utility activities are regulated by the Commission.
- 2. Dominion Energy and the city of Blanding both receive interstate natural gas transportation service from Williams NW Pipeline. Both entities receive supply at a common delivery point and transport their respective volumes through two pipelines (one

owned and operated by each party to the Blanding Agreement), that run parallel from the

interconnect with Williams NW Pipeline toward the city of Blanding. Each line is a one-

way feed, as described in the direct testimony of Austin C. Summers and accompanying

exhibits, which are attached hereto as DEU Exhibits 1.0 through 1.05, and that are

incorporated herein by this reference. The Blanding Agreement simply provides Blanding

with the ability to receive transportation service on Dominion Energy's facilities while the

Blanding-owned facilities are undergoing scheduled or emergency maintenance.

3. Because the Company proposes to waive Administrative charges and Basic

Service Fees for the MT service to Blanding, the Blanding Agreement is subject to

approval by the Commission. As discussed more fully in Mr. Summers' testimony, it is

appropriate to waive these charges and fees and approval of the Blanding Agreement is

just, reasonable and in the public interest.

WHEREFORE, Dominion Energy respectfully requests that the Commission enter

an Order approving the Blanding Agreement.
