DISCOVERY

Parties shall use their best efforts to respond to requests for data or discovery as quickly as possible. Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by electronic mail. In the event a document produced in response to a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by electronic mail, the party disclosing the document shall provide an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy).

NOTICE OF ELECTRONIC CONSOLIDATED HEARING

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 52-4-207, on this October 13, 2020, the chair of the PSC makes this written determination that, due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the continued risks of transmission in Utah, the consolidated hearing scheduled for **Tuesday, October 27, 2020, beginning at 9:00 a.m.** will be conducted as an electronic meeting without an anchor location. An anchor location would provide a substantial risk to the health and safety of those who may be present at the anchor location. This consolidated hearing will be conducted via Google Meet at the following link: meet.google.com/sie-zbun-uyu

All parties must have their witnesses in attendance and prepared to testify. The PSC requests that attorneys and witnesses make themselves available by both video and audio during the portions of the hearing in which they will be actively participating. Participants are free to deactivate video, and should always mute audio, when not actively participating. Participants

also may find it useful to have headphones or earbuds available in the event of feedback, since at times a participant's microphone may pick up the participant's voice twice, once from the person and another time from the computer speakers.
