Re: Motion of Dominion Energy Utah for Approval to Deviate from Applicable Tariff Provisions and Commission Rules in Response to COVID-19; Docket No. 20-057-T03

Dear Mr. Mendenhall:

The Public Service Commission (PSC) reviewed Dominion Energy Utah's (DEU) Notice of Resumption of Business Practices – Late Payment Fees ("Notice") filed on March 8, 2021. The Notice, filed pursuant to the PSC's Order Granting Motion issued March 16, 2020 in this docket ("Order"), informs the PSC that DEU will resume charging late payments fees effective April 7, 2021. The Order requires DEU to timely notify the PSC when it intends to resume its normal business practices.

The PSC also reviewed the Action Request response filed by the Division of Public Utilities (DPU) on March 22, 2021. DPU recommends the PSC approve DEU's request to resume its normal business practices related to late payment fees identified in the Notice. DPU states that, while DEU's stated reasons for waving certain fees in this docket (*i.e.*, the COVID-19 pandemic) have not entirely disappeared, DEU's proposed phased-in approach is reasonable.

Based on the PSC's review of DEU's Notice and DPU's comments and recommendation, the PSC acknowledges that DEU's Notice complies with the notification requirements in the Order.
