By The Commission:

Complainant filed his complaint alleging that Questar Gas failed to honor a deferred payment agreement regarding past due balances and as part of that agreement to accept electronic payments. Questar Gas responded by alleging that it had violated no tariff provisions, and requesting dismissal of the Complaint. On September 16, 2002, the Division of Public Utilities notified the Commission that it had confirmed with the Complainant that the issues in the complaint have been resolved to his satisfaction.

On the basis that this matter has been settled, we enter the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

1. The Complaint of Paul D. Hanseen v. Questar Gas Company is dismissed.
2. If any party wishes to proceed further, it may file a written petition for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure to do so will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
