By The Commission:

On May 31, 2002, Questar Gas Company (the Company) submitted its pass-through application in the above-entitled docket requesting a \$27,645,000 increase in the commodity portion of its rates and a \$1,000,000 decrease in the supplier non-gas portion of rates, to become effective July 1, 2002. The requested increase is due substantially to anticipated higher gas costs. The effect of this proposed change would increase the annual bill for a typical GS-1 residential customer using 1150 therms of gas per year by \$36.25 (or 5.32%).

On June 25, 2002, and June 27, 2002, the Division of Public Utilities ("DPU") submitted memoranda recommending granting the certain changes on an interim basis and keeping other rates the same. The Company concurred in the DPU's recommendation. On March 26, 2003, the DPU reported that it had completed its review of the filing and recommended that the interim rates be made final. No objection to that recommendation has been made.

<u>ORDER</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The interim rate changes for the I-2, IS-2, and T-1 rate classes placed in effect on an interim basis on July 1, 2002, are made final.
