By The Commission:

Morton Phillips ("Complainant") filed an informal complaint with the Division of Public Utilities ("Division") on March 26, 2003. In his complaint, Mr. Phillips claimed Questar was charging him \$1,563 to run the service line from the main gas line, across the street to the property line, then 35 feet to the location of the meter set. Complainant did not feel he should have to pay for the service line from across the street but should only be charged for the line from his property line to the meter set location.

The Division staff has contacted the complainant and confirmed that he has received a settlement agreement from Questar. On July 7, 2003 the Division sent the Public Service Commission a memo informing them that this case has been settled. The Division recommends that this case be dismissed.

On the basis that this matter has been settled, we enter the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

The complaint between Mr. Phillips and Questar is dismissed.
