REPORT AND ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

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# ISSUED: January 30, 2006

By The Commission:

On September 2, 2005, Complainant Utah Wood Preserving filed a formal complaint against Respondent Questar Gas Company ("Questar") claiming Respondent had wrongly billed Complainant's account. On October 3, 2005, Questar filed its Answer and Motion to Dismiss. On November 15, 2005, the Division of Public Utilities filed its analysis recommending the complaint be dismissed. On November 21, 2005, the Commission issued a Notice of Hearing setting a February 21, 2006, hearing in this matter.

On January 25, 2006, Respondent Questar filed a memorandum stating it had reached a settlement with Complainant. A copy of said settlement was attached to the memorandum. As part of the settlement, Complainant agrees to dismiss this matter. Based on this settlement, Respondent requests the previously scheduled hearing be cancelled.

Wherefore, based upon the foregoing information, and for good cause appearing, the Administrative Law Judge enters the following proposed

### <u>ORDER</u>

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The complaint filed herein is dismissed.

2. Pursuant to Utah Code §§ 63-46b-12 and 54-7-15, agency review or rehearing of this order may be obtained by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission

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within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code §§ 63-46b-14, 63-46b-16 and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
