ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

ISSUED: March 28, 2006

By The Commission:

On February 24, 2006, Questar Gas Company submitted a tariff filing regarding four different matters: (1) eliminating I-2, IS-2, and I-3 Rate Schedules; (2) required changes to make the tariff consistent with current company practices; (3) movement or deletion of sections; and (4) various grammatical and formatting changes that do not affect the meaning or applicability of the tariff. The Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) filed comments on these proposed changes on March 24, 2006. The Division recommends suspending the tariff to permit additional investigation of the proposed elimination of rate schedules I-2, IS-2, and I-3. The Division anticipates completing its investigation within the next few weeks with a resulting tariff effective date of May 1, 2006, if no further action is required.
