SYNOPSIS

Complainant having failed to appear to prosecute this matter, the Commission dismissed the same.

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By The Commission:

On December 3, 2007, Complainants Stephen and Colette Merrill filed a formal complaint against Respondent Questar Gas Company (“Questar”) claiming Respondent had wrongly estimated gas usage at their residence following the failure of their gas meter. On December 27, 2007, the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) filed its analysis recommending the complaint be dismissed. On January 11, 2008, Questar filed its Answer and Motion to Dismiss.

This matter came on for duly-noticed hearing before the Administrative Law Judge on February 5, 2008. Complainants failed to appear. Linda Kizerian appeared for Respondent. Questar employees were present and prepared to offer testimony and documentary evidence on behalf of Questar.

Therefore, based upon the foregoing information, and for good cause appearing, the Administrative Law Judge enters the following proposed:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The complaint filed herein is dismissed.

Pursuant to *Utah Code Annotated* §§ 63-46b-12 and 54-7-15, agency review or rehearing of this order may be obtained by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of *Utah Code Annotated* §§ 63-46b-14, 63-46b-16 and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
