On August 4, 1999, Questar Gas Company (QGC) applied for modification of its Transportation Nomination Schedule to change the daily deadline for orders from 11:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. QGC justified the application on the basis that the change brought QGC's Schedule into conformance with the Gas Industry Standards Board standard, brought QGC into Y2K compliance more economically, and increased convenience for customers in that they could avoid having to enter online orders through two different programs.
