Rocky Mountain Power's Proposed Fossil Fuel Energy Efficiency Standard Plan

On August 10, 2007, the Utah Commission issued its Determination Concerning the PURPA Fossil Fuel Generation Efficiency Standard and adopted the PURPA Fossil Fuel Generation Efficiency Standard. As part of that determination, the Commission directed its staff, the Company and others to convene a technical conference to "ensure that the Company's Fuel Efficiency Plan is apparent, provides sufficient information for evaluation, addresses the needs of the parties, and supports the goals of PURPA."

The first technical conference was held on September 12, 2007. At that technical conference, and in a second technical conference held on January 23, 2007, it was determined that Fossil Fuel Efficiency Plan would be provided, not only for entire system, but for each thermal plant in the fleet as well. Over a period a several months the content and format of the plan were developed through the collaborative work of the Commission staff, Division of Public Utilities, Committee of Consumer Services, the Company and others. A draft sample of the heat rate improvement plan for one plant was prepared and was circulated for comments to participants in the technical conferences in March 2008. No additional comments were received.

Enclosed for filing is a sample of the Rocky Mountain Power Fossil Fuel Energy Efficiency Standard Plan for the Huntington power plant. It is proposed that a complete plan for all of the plants be filed annually by March 31, with the first full report being due by March 31, 2009. The Company will also submit its summary of FERC Form 1 data at that time.
