Re: Sole Source Contract with Sandvik Mining and Construction to provide LS 175 Load-Haul-Dump Vehicles

## Commissioners:

In accordance with the Company's procurement policy, we hereby notify you that Energy West Mining Company, a subsidiary of PacifiCorp, has entered into a sole source contract with Sandvik Mining and Construction USA to supply two LS 175 Load-Haul-Dump vehicles, to be used by the Deer Creek Mine. The amount of this purchase is \$1.240,000 (\$620,000 each).

The Sandvik LS 175 "Load-Haul-Dump" (LHD) represents the only new manufactured diesel powered permissible loader that is MSHA (Part 36) approved for use in US underground mines. The LHD is used for material handling, construction project support, and longwall move support in the mine. Energy West contracted with Sandvik for 30 day machine trial at the Deer Creek Mine during July and August 2008. Based on the results of that trial it was determined that the LS 175 can be operated safely and will adequately meet the needs of the Deer Creek Mine.

This sole source procurement contract was authorized by Carl Pollastro, Manager of Operations, Interwest Mining Company. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
