In the December 17, 2009, Determination Concerning the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act (“PURPA”) Smart Grid Investment and Smart Grid Information Standards (“Smart Grid Determination”) in this proceeding, we found merit in the Utah Division of Public Utilities’ (“Division”) and the Rocky Mountain Power’s (“Company”) recommendation regarding monitoring the development of smart grid technologies and to consider their implementation as technologies mature and cost effectiveness analyses demonstrate appropriate benefits to the Company and its customers.
