Re: Follow up Letter for Renewable Energy Re Solar Resource in Oregon

Dear Commissioners:

The purpose of this letter is to inform the Commission that Rocky Mountain Power hereby withdraws its Notice Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 54-17-502(2)(e), filed with the Commission September 13, 2010, pertaining to PacifiCorp's intent to acquire the small solar resource described in PacifiCorp's letter to the Commission dated July 20, 2010. In that letter, PacifiCorp notified the Commission that, pursuant to ORS 757.370, PacifiCorp intended to acquire a solar resource with an output of greater than or equal to 500 kilowatts and less than or equal to 5 megawatts that would come into service 2011.

PacifiCorp does not intend to include the solar resource in Utah rate base because the resource is being acquired pursuant to an Oregon-specific mandate, under ORS 757.370. As such, PacifiCorp's position is that all costs the Company bears in meeting the requirements of ORS 757.370 should be borne solely by the state of Oregon and its customers.
