Re: Notice of Sole Source Contracts with: Blue Mountain Action Council, Yakima Farm Workers Clinic, Opportunities Industrialization Center of Washington

Commissioners:

In accordance with the Company's procurement policy, we hereby notify you that PacifiCorp has entered into five year sole source contracts with three agencies to perform low income weatherization services in the state of Washington, each of which exceed \$500,000. The contracts are with Blue Mountain Action Council for a maximum of \$180,000 per year, Yakima Farm Workers Clinic, dba Northwest Community Action Center, for a maximum of \$410,000 per year, and Opportunities Industrialization Center of Washington also for a maximum of \$410,000 per year.

The Washington Department of Commerce sub contracts with the three agencies listed above to perform low income weatherization services in Eastern Washington. These are the only agencies with the administrative and technical experience and capacity qualified to provide these services within the counties in Eastern Washington. The State of Washington authorizes these three agencies to receive funding to perform weatherization services from Department of Energy's Low Income Home Energy Assistance block grant which can be leveraged in combination with funding provided by PacifiCorp. Each of these agencies is monitored, including sample home installation inspections, by the state of Washington.

The sole source contracts were authorized on April 12, 2011, by Rich Walje, President, Rocky Mountain Power.
