Dear Mr. Widerburg:

Pursuant to Commitment U3(2), incorporated in the Public Service Commission of Utah's *Report and Order* approving the *Acquisition of PacifiCorp by MidAmerican Energy Holdings Company* (MEHC)<sup>1</sup>, issued January 27, 2006, as amended March 14, 2006, and June 5, 2006, Rocky Mountain Power d.b.a. PacifiCorp hereby provides notice of an affiliate interest transaction with BNSF Railway Company (BNSF) for a license allowing PacifiCorp to construct facilities to provide retail electric service to a customer in Toppenish, Washington. A verified copy of the License for Electric Supply Line Across or Along Railway Property, Tracking #14-3004 is included with this Notice as Attachment A.

PacifiCorp is a wholly-owned indirect subsidiary of Berkshire Hathaway Energy Company (BHE). BHE is a subsidiary of Berkshire Hathaway, Inc. (Berkshire Hathaway). As of March 31, 2010, Warren E. Buffet (an individual who may be deemed to control Berkshire Hathaway), Berkshire Hathaway, various subsidiaries of Berkshire Hathaway and various employee benefit plans of Berkshire Hathaway subsidiaries together held an interest in excess of 5 percent in BNSF. Therefore, Berkshire Hathaway's ownership interest in BNSF may create an affiliated interest in some PacifiCorp jurisdictions.

PacifiCorp needs to install new electric service to a retail customer in or near Toppenish, which will require crossing BNSF's property. PacifiCorp will pay BNSF \$3,000 for the license, \$1,600 for railroad protective liability insurance and \$600 in processing fees. Obtaining the license is in the public interest because it allows PacifiCorp to install and maintain facilities necessary to provide electric service and to meet its obligation to provide safe and reliable electric service. Not having the license would mean that PacifiCorp would not be able to meet its obligation to provide electric service. As the property owner, BNSF is the only entity that can provide this license to PacifiCorp.
