In the Matter of Miscellaneous Correspondence and Reports Regarding Gas Utility Services; 2014

RECOMMENDATION

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) recommends that the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission) take no action at this time.

ISSUE

On January 15, 2015 Questar Gas Company (Company) submitted its year-end Customer Satisfaction Standards Report (CSSR) to the Commission. On January 20, 2015 the Commission issued its Action Request to the Division to: "review for Compliance and Make Recommendations". This is the Division's response to the Commission's request.

BACKGROUND

The Commission's order in Docket No.14-999-02 stated in part, that "As of the date of this order, we discontinue Questar's requirement to file a quarterly CCSR with the Commission and other parties." Also, in its letter to the Commission in this filing, the Company stated; "Following discussions with the Division and direction provided by the Commission order in



Docket 14-999-02, the Company will provide this report on an annual basis." The Company's filing of January 15, 2015 is its 2014 annual CSSR filing.

DISCUSSION

The filing of an annual CSSR filing does not appear to fulfill a specific regulatory requirement. While not specifically addressed in the order, in prior years the Company has filed an annual CSSR as a matter of practice. Following the Commission's October 23, 2014 order which discontinued the quarterly filing, the parties discussed whether or not the order was applicable to an annual filing. After considerable discussion, parties agreed that; 1) The Company should file an annual CSSR for calendar year 2014 since it already filed quarterly reports within the year, and 2) The Company may, but is not required to file annual CSSR's in the future.

CONCLUSION

The Division has reviewed the Company's CSSR filing and recommends that since it was not offered to fulfill a Commission order, it is informational only. As such the Commission need not take any action. Therefore, the Division recommends that the Commission take no action in this matter.
