Re: Notice of Non-Competitive Procurement with GE-Prolec Transformers Inc.

Commissioners:

In accordance with PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, the Company must report to the Commission purchases of goods or services exceeding \$500,000 that are not competitively bid. This letter hereby serves as notice that, on January 30, 2015, PacifiCorp entered into a non-competitively bid contract extension with GE-Prolec Transformers Inc. ("GE-Prolec"), which exceeds \$500,000. The contract extension has a projected cost of \$8 million.

Pursuant to PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, a supplier may be awarded a contract on a non-competitive basis under certain circumstances, such as when competitive bidding is impossible or impractical, or when otherwise a non-competitive procurement has been demonstrated to be in the best interest of the Company. Accordingly, the contract amendment entered into by PacifiCorp with GE-Prolec was justified. GE-Prolec currently supplies distribution transformers and other equipment and services to PacifiCorp and this amendment extends the period of performance to December 31, 2015 in order to ensure a continuity of service for the Company.
