Re: Notice of Non-Competitive Procurement with Cooper Power Systems, LLC

## Commissioners:

In accordance with PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, the Company must report to the Commission purchases of goods or services exceeding \$500,000 that are not competitively bid. This letter hereby serves as notice that, on January 30, 2015, PacifiCorp entered into a non-competitively bid contract extension with Cooper Power Systems, LLC ("Cooper Power Systems"), which exceeds \$500,000. The contract extension has a projected cost of \$1.9 million.

Pursuant to PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, a supplier may be awarded a contract on a non-competitive basis under certain circumstances, such as when competitive bidding is impossible or impractical, or when otherwise a non-competitive procurement has been demonstrated to be in the best interest of the Company. Accordingly, the contract amendment entered into by PacifiCorp with Cooper Power Systems was justified. Cooper Power Systems currently supplies distribution transformers and other equipment and services to PacifiCorp and this amendment extends the period of performance to December 31, 2015 in order to ensure a continuity of service for the Company.
