Re: Notice of Non-Competitive Procurement with NWFF Environmental, Inc.

Commissioners:

In accordance with PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, the Company must report to the Commission purchases of goods or services exceeding \$500,000 that are not competitively bid. This letter hereby serves as notice that, on May 19, 2015, PacifiCorp entered into a non-competitively bid amendment to an active general services contract with NWFF Environmental Inc. ("NWFF"), which exceeds \$500,000. The amendment to the contract serves to extend the term of the contract and has a projected additional cost of \$1 million.

Pursuant to PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, a supplier may be awarded a contract on a non-competitive basis under certain circumstances, such as when competitive bidding is impossible or impractical, or when otherwise a non-competitive procurement has been demonstrated to be in the best interest of the Company. Accordingly, the contract amendment entered into by PacifiCorp with NWFF was justified. NWFF currently provides emergency spill response and general remediation services for the Company, and the extension of the contract through December 31, 2015 ensures a continuity of service for PacifiCorp while it completes a competitive bid process for additional service in 2016 and beyond.
