Re: Notice of Non-Competitive Procurement with Fujitsu Consulting, Inc.

## Commissioners:

In accordance with PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, the Company must report to the Commission purchases of goods or services exceeding \$500,000 that are not competitively bid. This letter hereby serves as notice that, on July 6, 2015, PacifiCorp added funds to an existing non-competitively bid purchase order with Fujitsu Consulting, Inc. ("Fujitsu Consulting"), which exceeds \$500,000 in total. The purchase order with the additional funds has a projected cost of \$640,000.

Pursuant to PacifiCorp's Procurement Policy, a supplier may be awarded a contract on a non-competitive basis under certain circumstances, such as when competitive bidding is impossible or impractical, or when otherwise a non-competitive procurement has been demonstrated to be in the best interest of the Company. Accordingly, PacifiCorp adding funds to an existing non-competitively bid purchase order with Fujitsu Consulting was justified. Fujitsu Consulting currently provides PacifiCorp with SAP Basis support services and increasing the value for as yet unfinished work under the purchase order will ensure a continuity of service for the Company.
