<u>Subject:</u> Pre-filing workshops sponsored by Questar Gas Company regarding its 2015 Integrated Resource Plan filing with the Public Service Commission of Utah.

IRP Workshop Dates:

Monday, February 9, 2015 – Potential topics include a review of the 2014 Commission IRP Order; review of the December 30 and 31, 2014, weather event; calculation of the prices of cost-of-service gas and market purchased gas; and discussion of the determination of the 65 percent annual forecast demand pursuant to the Trail Acquisition Stipulation.

Wednesday, March 25, 2015 – **Confidential Meeting** – Potential topics include an update of Wexpro activities including its proposed drilling program and compression and a review of Questar's upstream gathering and transportation contracts.

Monday, May 4, 2015 – Confidential Meeting – Potential topics include a review of: the 2014-2015 heating season including the use of natural gas storage aquifers, Questar's annual natural gas request for proposal, and Questar's activities associated with management of cost-of-service gas during the 2014 IRP year.
