The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has reviewed and conducted a desk audit of the Semi-annual Lifeline Report of Direct Communications Cedar Valley, pursuant to Administrative Rule R746-341-7(A), for the period of January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016. The Division finds that the amounts claimed are reasonable and justified. The desk audit included a review of the amounts and numbers submitted on the invoice, a comparison to previous reports and a review with information from the Department of Workforce Services (DWS).

Direct Communications Cedar Valley submitted claims for administrative, advertising, voucher or other program expenses of \$234.50 for the period. The Company did not request reimbursement of interest revenue on Lifeline funds. No outreach efforts were reported due to the agreement with the DWS, Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) and the Division.

The Division recommends the Commission disburse from the Universal Service Fund the amount equal to the program expenses and discounts granted of **\$486.50** to:
