On December 28, 2018, as amended on February 25, 2019, PacifiCorp filed an Amended and Restated Project Construction Agreement (Agreement) between PacifiCorp Energy Supply Management (ESM) and PacifiCorp Transmission (PacifiCorp). PacifiCorp states that the Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions under which PacifiCorp will perform, at ESM's expense, modifications to the Spanish Fork and Timp substations to accommodate a separate request by ESM for network transmission service. The Agreement is accepted for filing, effective December 20, 2018, as requested.

The filing was noticed on December 28, 2018 and February 25, 2019, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before January 18, 2019 and March 18, 2019, respectively. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PacifiCorp.

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This action is taken pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307. This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
