Notice of Termination

Dear Secretary Bose:

Pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824d (2012), Part 35 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (“FERC” or the “Commission”) regulations, 18 C.F.R. Part 35 (2018), and Order No. 714¹ regarding electronic filing of tariff submittals, PacifiCorp hereby notifies the Commission that it is terminating PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 731, a Project Construction Agreement (“Construction Agreement”) dated January 23, 2018, between Utah Associated Municipal Power Systems (“UAMPS”) and PacifiCorp.

1. Background and Reason for Filing

PacifiCorp and UAMPS jointly own certain assets at and between the St. George and Red Butte/ Central substations in South-West Utah, including a double-circuit 345 kV transmission line that had one circuit energized to 138 kV and one circuit un-energized. On January 23, 2018, PacifiCorp and UAMPS entered into the Construction Agreement, under which PacifiCorp agreed to perform and UAMPS agreed to pay for its share of work to install equipment necessary to energize the jointly owned, un-energized circuit at 138 kV.

On February 6, 2018, PacifiCorp filed the Construction Agreement with the Commission in Docket No. ER18-813-000. The Agreement was designated as PacifiCorp Rate Schedule No. 731. The Commission accepted the filing on March 26, 2018, via letter order², effective April 9, 2018.

Sections 2.2 through 2.2(i) of the Construction Agreement state, in relevant part, that the Construction Agreement “shall terminate ninety (90) calendar days after the earliest of the following to occur: (i) [PacifiCorp’s] receipt of final payment under this Agreement of UAMPS’ share of actual costs” On June 21, 2019, PacifiCorp settled with UAMPS all costs of the work provided for under the Construction Agreement. Accordingly, PacifiCorp now seeks to terminate the Construction Agreement pursuant to its own terms.
