The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has reviewed and conducted a desk audit of the semi-annual report for Direct Communications Cedar Valley (Company), pursuant to Rule R746-8-403 2)(a), for the period of July 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019. The desk audit included a review of the amount and numbers submitted on the Request for Utah Lifeline Discount Reimbursement form, a comparison to previous reports, and a review of information received from the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC).
