SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF AT&T

AT&T Services, Inc., on behalf of its affiliate, AT&T Corp. (referred to herein as "AT&T") applies for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended ("the Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.71, to discontinue AT&T All In One Local Exchange Service throughout its service territory in Arizona, Colorado, Minnesota, Nebraska, Oregon, Utah, and Washington.

As required by Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, AT&T provides the following information:

Name and Address of Carrier:

AT&T Corp.

Date of Planned Service Discontinuance:

Effective on or after October 1, 2020, pending regulatory approval, AT&T All In One Local Exchange Service will be discontinued and will no longer be available for purchase by new or existing customers.

Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected:

AT&T will no longer offer AT&T All In One Local Exchange Service throughout its service territory in Arizona, Colorado, Minnesota, Nebraska, Oregon, Utah, and Washington.

Brief Description of Type of Service Affected:

AT&T All In One Local Exchange Service provides small business customers with an analog communications channel that allows them to place and receive local voice phone calls and facilitates intrastate and interstate long distance calls.

AT&T is discontinuing AT&T All In One Local Exchange Service because demand has declined significantly. The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by the discontinuance of this service because there are alternative voice services available to these customers, including AT&T's Office@Hand service, which is a cloud-based IP service that enables customers to connect seamlessly on almost any device using only one number for all their business voice, fax, and text messages. Further, AT&T is a reseller in the affected service areas and replacement services are also available from other carriers, such as CenturyLink, the incumbent local exchange carrier throughout the affected service area.¹

¹ AT&T's action to discontinue AT&T All In One Local Service is not a "Technology Transition" as defined in 47 CFR 63.60(i) because customers are not required to replace their service with a different technology or medium for transmission. CenturyLink continues to offer TDM-based local voice service throughout AT&T's service area included in this discontinuance.

Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers:

Customer notices were sent via U.S. Mail on June 23, 2020.² Copies of this Application are being sent, first class U.S. Mail to the public utility commission, governor, federally recognized tribes (if any) in the affected state, and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.

Regulatory Classification of Carrier:

AT&T offers AT&T All In One Local Service pursuant to non-dominant carrier regulation.
