In accordance with Utah Administrative Rule R930-5, a highway railroad grade crossing surveillance review was conducted on February 1, 2017 for the above crossing in Pleasant View, Utah.

Background Information:

An intersection improvement and rehabilitation project on 1400 North in Logan will affect the railroad crossing at 600 West. The intersection is currently a 4-way stop, but will be upgraded to become a fully signalized intersection. The railroad crossing is located approximately 40 feet east of the intersection, and is controlled by crossbucks with yield signs. This line is used only a few times per week with train speeds not exceeding 10 mph.

Specific Recommendations:

- 1. The crossing will be upgraded to feature lights and gates, including in the median.
- 2. The new traffic signal at the intersection will be constructed with railroad interconnection.

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- 3. The new traffic signal will include a pre_signal which will provide adequate traffic control for all three westbound lanes. Therefore, no railroad cantilevers will be required.
- 4. Pedestrian safety devices per the *Rural Pedestrian Grade Crossings Flow Chart*, which is included in the <u>UDOT Pedestrian Grade Crossing Manual</u>.
- 5. Replace all crossing panels and extend panels to 3 ft beyond the sidewalk.
- 6. Install pavement markings to meet UDOT Standard Drawing ST-07.
