Subject: Docket No. 02-2270-01 All West's Request for Revision to Qwest Exchange Boundary.

The Division has been actively investigating All West's request to transfer a portion of Qwest's Park City serving area know as the "Promontory Development" to All West Communications, Inc. In an effort to gather information, the Division has had meetings and sent data requests to both companies. All West notified the Division that they would like to delay the response to the data request and put the proposal to the Commission on hold which would allow continued discussions with Qwest. Qwest has responded to the Division's data request.

The Division Staff does not believe that it is appropriate to make a recommendation until All West has had the opportunity to pursue all avenues of negotiation with Qwest. Accordingly, is honoring All West's request to delay the response to the data request. Moreover, to our knowledge, All West has not withdrawn the petition to serve the area, therefore, we have placed this project on hold until notification from All West of their intent.

The Division will advise the Commission when All West communicates its desires to continue its pursuit of the request to transfer the Qwest Promontory area.
