The outcome of Qwest Corporation's LDA Tariff docket could result in significant added costs to consumers. This is due to increased development and home building time, caused by slow response time to project timetables on the part of

telephone and other utilities to Fieldstone Homes. Thus, the legal interests of Fieldstone Homes could be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding.

3. The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding will not be impaired by allowing Fieldstone Homes to intervene.

WHEREFORE, Fieldstone Homes respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order graining Fieldstone Homes Petition to Intervene as a party in this docket, allowing Fieldstone Homes to participate to the full extent allowed by the rules of the Commission and by Utah Law.
