U S DEVELOPMENT PETITION TO INTERVENE

Rule 746-100-7, U S Development respectfully petitions the Public Service Commission of Utah (the "Commission") for leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding concerning Qwest Corporation's Land Development Agreements tariff provisions in the state of Utah. In support of its petition, U S Development represents and states as follows:

- 1. U S Development is a Developer/ Home Builder, developing and building over 300 homes per year in residential subdivisions throughout the state of Utah and specifically along the Wasatch Front.
- 2. As a Developer/ Home Builder, U S Development is required by law to provide utilities, including telephone service, to the building lots we develop and /or the homes we build in Utah. The outcome of Qwest Corporation's LDA Tariff docket could result in significant added costs to consumers. This is due to increased development and home building time, caused by slow response time to project timetables on the part of

telephone and other utilities to U S Development. Thus, the legal interests of U S Development could be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding.

3. The interests of justice and the orderly and prompt conduct of this proceeding will not be impaired by allowing U S Development to intervene.

WHEREFORE, US Development respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order graining US Development Petition to Intervene as a party in this docket, allowing US Development to participate to the full extent allowed by the rules of the Commission and by Utah Law.
