By The Commission:

A scheduling conference was held before the Administrative Law Judge on November 19, 2004, at which time the parties agreed to conduct this arbitration in accordance with the schedule provided below. Robert Brown appeared for Qwest Corporation (Qwest). Union Cellular (Union) was represented by Stephen Mecham and Bruce Asay (by telephone). Michael Ginsberg appeared on behalf of the Division of Public Utilities. As indicated below, Qwest agreed to an extension of Union's deadline to file its Response to Qwest's Motion to Strike Union's Response to Petition for Arbitration and Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings from November 19, 2004, to November 26, 2004. Counsel for Qwest also noted that although Qwest's Request for Arbitration had contained a request for protective order, Qwest does not currently believe there is a need for a protective order to issue in this docket.

Therefore, unless later modified by the Commission, the following dates shall constitute the schedule in this docket:

November 26, 2004 –	Deadline for Union to file Response to Qwest's Motion to Strike Union's Response to Petition for Arbitration and Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings
November 26, 2004 –	Deadline for parties to file Direct Testimony
December 10, 2004 –	Deadline for parties to file Rebuttal Testimony and Issues Matrix
December 20, 2004 –	Hearing, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the ALJ's hearing room, Room 451, Heber M. Wells Building, Salt Lake City, Utah.

January 4, 2005 – Deadline for filing briefs

The parties agree to conduct discovery with a 10 calendar day turnaround. Electronic filing will be conducted by email with paper copy to follow by regular mail.

The parties will inform the Commission of the resolution of contested items throughout these proceedings. As part of their final briefs, the parties will identify which issues remain open for resolution by the Commission.
