1	PROCEEDINGS
2	JUDGE GOODWILL: This is the Public
3	Service Commission hearing in the matter of the
4	application of Beehive Telephone Company,
5	Incorporated for a Certificate of Public Convenience
6	and Necessity to provide local exchange services
7	within the State of Utah. Public Service Commission
8	Docket Number 06-051-01.
9	I am Steve Goodwill, the Administrative
10	Law Judge for the Commission. And I have been
11	assigned by the Commission to hear this matter.
12	Notice of this hearing was issued by the
13	Commission on April 13th, 2007. And on April 17th,
14	2007 an amendment was issued notifying interested
15	persons that the hearing will consider the
16	stipulation filed that same day, April 17th, 2007, by
17	the Division of Public Utilities, Beehive Telecom and
18	Beehive Telephone.
19	At this point, I would like to go ahead
20	and take appearances.
21	We'll start with the applicant, Beehive
22	Telephone.
23	MS. HOOPER: Judith Hooper, for Beehive.
24	MS. SCHMID: Patricia E. Schmid, from the
25	Attorney General's office, representing the Division

- 1 of Public Utilities.
- 2 MR. MECHAM: Steve Mecham, representing
- 3 Utah Rural Telecom Association.
- 4 JUDGE GOODWILL: Okay. Ms. Hooper, just
- 5 so we're clear, you represent both Beehive Telephone
- 6 and Beehive Telecom in this matter?
- 7 MS. HOOPER: That's correct.
- 8 JUDGE GOODWILL: And it's my understanding
- 9 that although the applicant is Beehive Telephone
- 10 Company, any certificate that would issue in this
- 11 matter would be issued to Beehive Telecom as the
- 12 CLEC?
- 13 MS. HOOPER: That's correct.
- 14 JUDGE GOODWILL: With that, I guess it
- makes most sense to turn to the Division.
- 16 MS. SCHMID: Okay. The Division has a
- 17 witness in support of the stipulation which has been
- 18 filed with the Commission.
- 19 Could the Division witness, Mr.
- 20 Christopher Lucas -- Luras, please be sworn?
- JUDGE GOODWILL: Sure.
- 22 Could you please stand and raise your
- 23 right hand.
- 24 CHRISTOPHER LURAS,
- called as a witness, being first duly sworn,

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- was examined and testified as follows:
- 2 JUDGE GOODWILL: Thank you. Please be
- 3 seated.
- 4 Ms. Schmid.
- 5 BY MS. SCHMID:
- 6 Q. Could you please state your full name and
- 7 spell your last name for the record.
- 8 A. Christopher James Luras, L-U-R-A-S.
- 9 Q. By whom are you employed and in what
- 10 capacity?
- 11 A. The Utah Division of Public Utilities, as
- 12 a technical consultant.
- Q. Could you please provide this hearing with
- 14 your business address?
- 15 A. 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah
- 16 84111.
- 17 Q. Thank you.
- 18 Mr. Luras, have you been involved on
- 19 behalf of the Division in this docket?
- 20 A. I have.
- Q. Were you involved in the preparation of a
- 22 memorandum, dated January 16th, 2007, filed with the
- 23 Commission?
- 24 A. I was.
- MS. SCHMID: The Commission -- the

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- 1 Division would like to move the admission of this
- 2 memorandum, which has been pre-marked for
- 3 identification as DPU Exhibit 1.
- 4 And I would like to apologize because I
- 5 neglected to staple the copies.
- 6 JUDGE GOODWILL: I'm sorry. Did you go
- 7 ahead and move this into admission?
- 8 MS. SCHMID: I did. Please.
- 9 JUDGE GOODWILL: Any objections?
- 10 MS. HOOPER: No objections.
- 11 JUDGE GOODWILL: All right. We'll admit
- 12 it.
- 13 (DPU EXHIBIT-1 WAS ADMITTED.)
- 14 Q. (By Ms. Schmid) Mr. Luras, do you have a
- 15 summary in support of the stipulation that you would
- 16 like to present?
- 17 A. I do.
- 18 O. Please proceed.
- 19 A. Through correspondence and several
- 20 meetings with Beehive, the Division has developed a
- 21 good understanding of their intentions of their
- 22 application.
- 23 Initially we had concerns over whether
- 24 Behhive CLEC was going to be providing retail service
- in Beehive's ILEC service territory. However, as

- detailed in the stipulation, Beehive CLEC will not be
- 2 providing retail service in Beehive's ILEC service
- 3 territory.
- 4 We therefore find no reason to oppose the
- 5 application.
- 6 The stipulation, we believe, is in the
- 7 public interest. We believe that it will enhance
- 8 competition in Tooele. It will grant Beehive
- 9 flexibility. And it will also allow the Commission
- 10 regulatory oversight of the arrangement detailed in
- 11 the stipulation.
- 12 Q. Thank you.
- 13 MS. SCHMID: Mr. Luras is now available
- 14 for cross-examination.
- 15 And one thing before then, would the
- 16 Administrative Law Judge like the stipulation to be
- 17 offered as an exhibit?
- 18 JUDGE GOODWILL: Might as well, if you've
- 19 got a copy.
- MS. SCHMID: I have one copy.
- 21 JUDGE GOODWILL: I believe all the parties
- 22 have copies of the stipulation.
- MS. SCHMID: So the DPU will then offer
- 24 what we'll mark for identification as DPU Exhibit 2,
- which is the stipulation between Beehive Telecom, the

- 1 Utah Division of Public Utilities and Beehive
- 2 Telephone Company. It consists of multiple pages, a
- 3 total of seven because of signature pages.
- 4 And I'll just give that to the court
- 5 reporter.
- JUDGE GOODWILL: That will be great.
- 7 Thanks.
- 8 Any objection to its admission?
- 9 MS. HOOPER: No.
- MR. MECHAM: No.
- JUDGE GOODWILL: Okay. We'll go ahead and
- 12 admit it as DPU Exhibit 2.
- 13 (DPU EXHIBIT-2 WAS ADMITTED.)
- JUDGE GOODWILL: Ms. Hooper, I take it you
- don't have any questions of Mr. Luras?
- MS. HOOPER: I do not.
- JUDGE GOODWILL: Mr. Mecham?
- MR. MECHAM: None.
- 19 JUDGE GOODWILL: I have just a couple.
- 20 Mr. Larus, regarding the memorandum that
- 21 we've now entered as DPU Exhibit 1, Division
- memorandum of January 16th of this year, I take it
- then it's the Division's position, given the
- 24 stipulation and the nature of the certificate that
- would issue, that the issues that were addressed in

- that memorandum are mooted or no longer at issue?
- THE WITNESS: Correct.
- JUDGE GOODWILL: Specifically, it's my
- 4 understanding from reading the stipulation that there
- 5 would be no impact currently on USFs?
- 6 THE WITNESS: There would not.
- 7 JUDGE GOODWILL: Okay. Now given that --
- 8 again, I'll just ask the question to make sure we're
- 9 all clear. I know at the technical conference a few
- 10 weeks ago there was some discussion of Beehive's
- desire at some point to offer services through its
- 12 CLEC in the boundary area between Beehive Telephone
- and Qwest. According to the stipulation, Beehive
- 14 Telecom will not be offering any retail services
- 15 within that service area.
- 16 Is that your understanding and the
- 17 Division's understanding?
- 18 THE WITNESS: Yeah. My understanding is
- 19 that that area is not part of the stipulation. That
- 20 is a separate issue.
- 21 The area outside of Beehive's ILEC
- 22 territory, is that what you're --
- JUDGE GOODWILL: Well, I guess there was
- some issue about just where that territory ended and
- Qwest's territory begins. So there is an issue as to

- where Beehive's CLEC may be entitled to serve.
- 2 THE WITNESS: According to the
- 3 stipulation, they are not entitled to serve in their
- 4 ILEC's territory.
- 5 If it is determined that some of that area
- 6 is Qwest's territory, then they would be allowed to
- 7 serve in that territory. But I don't believe we have
- 8 the boundaries of that.
- 9 But that's a separate issue and it's not
- 10 within the scope of the stipulation.
- JUDGE GOODWILL: Okay. Any other
- 12 questioning of Mr. Larus?
- MR. MECHAM: None from me.
- MS. HOOPER: None.
- JUDGE GOODWILL: Anything further, Ms.
- 16 Schmid?
- 17 MS. SCHMID: Nothing from the Division.
- 18 JUDGE GOODWILL: A lot shorter than it
- 19 appeared it would be six months ago.
- 20 MS. SCHMID: Testament to the settlement
- 21 and stipulation process.
- JUDGE GOODWILL: Again, you may have
- mentioned this, Mr. Larus, in your summary, but just
- to make sure we have it on the record, I take it it's
- 25 the Division's position then, as stated in the

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stipulation at issue, a certificate, as agreed to in
 1
      the stipulation, would be in the public interest?
