By The Commission:

On August 11, 2008, we issued a Report and Order approving the designation of Qwest Corporation's (Qwest) Draper Utah wire center as a Tier 2 wire center. We based our decision on the recommendation of the Division of Public Utilities, which had reviewed Qwest's supporting information and, by Memorandum dated July 30, 3008, recommended approval of the petition. At the time, it appeared there was no opposition to the designation as no opposing comments or pleadings had been submitted. We, erroneously, believed that all interested parties had had opportunity, as the Division, to review the supporting material.

On August 11, 2008, Integra Telecom of Utah, Inc., and XO Communications

Services, Inc., filed a letter objection to the designation, followed by an August 13, 2008, Motion
to Vacate or Alternatively Review or Rehearing of Report and Order. They indicate that have
not had opportunity to adequately complete their review of the supporting information. They
state they believe what appear to be inconsistencies, in their view of the wire count data, likely
will be resolved, as in past proceedings, but ask for additional time to reach that conclusion.

Based on the foregoing, we enter this order granting review and staying our August 11, 2008, Report and Order. We do this to provide Intergra Telecom of Utah and XO

Communications Services additional time to complete their review and reach agreement with Qwest on the line counts for the Draper wire center.
