By The Commission:

Beehive Telephone Company, Inc. (Company), requested a hearing before the Public Service Commission as a whole. In its Request, it stated that issues raised in its motions and in motions filed by the Division of Public Utilities and the Committee of Consumer Services raised issue of “significant public interest” within the meaning of section 54-1-1(2)(a)(ii). It claimed that the Commissioners, rather than the Commission’s administrative law judge, should hear oral argument on the motions.

We have reviewed the Company’s Request and the moving and responding papers related to the pending motions. We find that the issues are not of such significant public interest that the issues should be heard by the Commission as a whole, rather than the administrative law judge. The Company’s Request for Hearing is denied.
