RECOMMENDATION: acknowledge receipt

ISSUES:

On February 9, 2009, Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") filed the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement per the above-referenced docket in accordance with § 54-8b-2.2(1)(d) of the *Utah Code*. This Agreement had been fully executed through voluntary negotiations on February 4, 2009 with Central Telcom Services, LLC ("Central Telcom") dba Centracom Interactive CTS. Central Telcom's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity was approved by the Commission on February 4, 2008 in Docket No. 07-2388-01.

The Division has reviewed the above-mentioned Agreement between Qwest and Central Telcom and sees no reason to reject it. Specifically, the Division believes that the Agreement was negotiated in good faith and without unfair discrimination. Both parties also recognize that, to the extent that the existing rules are changed, vacated, dismissed, stayed or modified, this Agreement and all contracts adopting all or part of this Agreement will be amended to reflect such modification or change of the existing rules. Therefore, the Division recommends that the Commission acknowledge the receipt of this Interconnection Agreement.
