PETITION TO INTERVENE

For an Amended Certificate of Public
Convenience and Necessity to Provide Local
Exchange Services within the State of Utah

DOCKET NO. 09-051-02

Carbon/Emery Telcom, Inc. (“Carbon/Emery”), pursuant to Section 63-46b-9 Utah Code Ann. (2001) and Utah Admin. R. 746-100-7, respectfully petitions the Public Service Commission of Utah for leave to intervene in the above-captioned docket. Carbon/Emery seeks to intervene on the following grounds:

1. Carbon/Emery is the Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier (ILEC) in the local exchange area in and around Price, Utah, operating in Utah pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity previously issued by the Commission. Beehive Telecom, Inc. (“Beehive”) seeks amendment to its presently held Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to permit it to provide intrastate and interexchange services within and throughout the State of Utah, specifically in all or part of the service territories of incumbent local exchange carriers (ILECs), with greater than 5,000 access lines that are owned or controlled by ILECs with greater than 30,000 access lines in the State of Utah. As the ILEC in the Price, Utah local exchange

area, Carbon/Emery has a substantial interest in this proceeding. The issues to be considered by the Commission may impact Carbon/Emery's business interests, operations, as well as the interests of the subscribers, residential and commercial, that Carbon/Emery services in the Price, Utah exchange. Those issues may also impact Carbon/Emery's continued ability to provide enhanced telecommunications services to the subscribers the Price, Utah exchange.

2. The interests of justice and the orderly conduct of these proceedings will not be impaired by allowing Carbon/Emery's participation. Beehive's application was recently filed April 6, 2009, therefore Carbon/Emery's Petition to Intervene is prompt and timely, and its intervention and participation will not delay the proceedings in any way.
