Re: In the Matter of the Petition of MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services and MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services for a Waiver of Regulatory Requirements to File Price Lists for Services to Enterprise and Large Business Customers, and to Permit Deviation from the Rule Requiring Paper Billing for Customers Who Want Electronic Bills in Lieu of Paper Bills Docket No. 09-2430-01

Recommendation:

Provide notice and schedule a hearing as outlined in Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-3.

Issues:

On February 4, 2009 MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services and MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services (“Verizon”) filed a waiver of certain regulatory requirements with the Commission. Utah Code Ann. § 54-8b-3 allows for the Commission to issue an order exempting any telecommunications corporation from any requirement, after public notice and a hearing. The Division recommends the Commission give public notice of the proposed changes as well as scheduling a hearing for this Docket. This will allow the opportunity for all interested parties to participate in this proceeding.
