Re: Withdrawal of Utah Docket No. 10-041-T01, Citizens Telecommunications

Company of Utah filing to modify Special Condition A8 allowing Centrex

customers to purchase Frontier Business Unlimited Service

ISSUE:

Citizens previously filed this docket to modify its tariff to allow its Centrex customers to purchase Frontier Business Unlimited Service. This change appeared in Paragraph A8 under Conditions on Sheet No. 38 of Schedule No A-3. The service called Centrex was to be omitted from the sentence that restricts certain services from being used in conjunction with bundled service.

Citizens has now asked for this advise letter to be withdrawn.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Division has reviewed this withdrawal notice and sees no reason to reject it. The Division therefore recommends that the Commission approve this withdrawal of a Citizen's tariff change which was to go into effect February 15, 2010.
