## **ISSUE:**

Citizens Telecommunications is filing this docket to modify its tariff to change the name of Frontier Digital Phone Essentials to Frontier Digital Phone 100 and introduce three new bundles called Frontier Digital Phone Essentials 1, 2, and 3 available to residential customers.

This change appears in Schedule No. A-3 under Bundled Services. An existing bundle is renamed and three new bundles are created.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Division has reviewed this modification for any rate increase to base rates that would require a rate hearing and has found none. The Division therefore recommends that the Commission approve this modification in Citizens' General Exchange Tariff and have it become effective May 21, 2010.
