Re: Utah Docket No. 10-041-T05, Citizens Telecommunications Company of Utah filing to remove calling features that were included in the Frontier Business Unlimited Service, reduce the monthly rate and introduce a new feature package.

ISSUE:

Citizens Telecommunications previously filed this docket to modify its tariff to remove calling features that were included in the Frontier Business Unlimited Service, reduce the monthly rate and introduce a new feature package called Frontier Business Essentials Service. This docket also discontinues the previous Frontier Business Essentials bundle.

These changes appear in Schedule No. A-3 under Bundled Services and in Schedule No. X-1 under Discontinued Services.

In a new withdrawal letter, Citizens has now asked for this Advise letter to be withdrawn.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Division has reviewed this tariff modification and subsequent withdrawal letter and recommends that the Commission take no action and withdraw this modification in Citizens' General Exchange as requested.
